Carlton Landing is Oklahoma's newest town. Grant and Jen Humphreys, the lakeside community's first residents, founded the community in 2011. The town occupies one of Lake Eufaula's most picturesque areas, with sandy beaches, towering cliffs, beautiful woodlands and some of the lake's finest water quality. Famed planner and architect Andreas Duany, known for designing the Rosemary Beach and Seaside communities on the Florida panhandle, crafted the Carlton Landing master plan with Humphreys in 2008. Inspired by the New Urbanism movement—which holds that life, work and play are all central to a community's vitality—Carlton Landing is the first development of its kind to become a distinct municipality. The master plan includes schools, a waterfront
